

Update on NIOSH Extramural Funding for FY2009

The NIOSH Office of Extramural Programs (OEP) is operating under a continuing resolution (CR) that currently extends through March 6, 2009. During the continuing resolution NIOSH will continue to receive and review new and revised applications.

Paylines/New Awards

Official paylines for the 200810 Council have not been established because NIOSH is currently under a continuing resolution and does not have a firm budget for new awards. There is a possibility that new extramural awards may not be made until the final FY 2009 appropriation has been made by Congress.

Applicants who received priority scores above the estimated 200810 paylines are encouraged to review their summary statement and consult with the Scientific Program Officer assigned to their application.

Projects Currently Funded

NIOSH anticipates there will be a rescission applied to its FY2009 budget. The extent to which Type 5 awards (non-competitive continuations) may be impacted is presently not known.
