JULY/AUGUST 1974 REVIEW CYCLE

During the May/June 1974 Review Cycle, the Nebraska RMP was awarded \$902,661 for the 1/1/74-6/30/75 budget period.

Application: The July 1, supplemental continuation grant application requests \$110,758 for initiation of seven new project activities. These activities include Hospital-Community-Home Coordinator (Indian), dental services, Antenatal Obstetrical Center, ophthalmology, hyperlipidemia, hypertension, master medical calendar.

The Nebraska State Office of Comprehensive Health Planning, the Central Nebraska CHP Council, and the HPC of the Midlands have submitted significant negative comments regarding four of the seven proposals. Nebraska RMP program staff are following up these comments in order to resolve the issues.

NATIONAL ADVISORY COUNCIL - June 13-14, 1974

Council recommended that the Nebraska RMP application be funded at the level of \$950,000 rather than at the Committee's suggested level of \$912,000. The increase was to permit the RMP to initiate Kidney activities.
