

ACCESS: Travel Highway 101 to the Duckabush Recreation Area, FS Rd. #2510 (22 miles north of Hoodsport.) Follow road for 6.2 mi. to FS Rd. #2530, turn right on this road and drive 1.3 mi. to the trailhead.



FACILITIES: There is a small parking area at the trailhead. The nearest potable water is at Collins Campground when the campground is open (May to September).

SETTING: This trail goes through second growth forest to old growth forest around the falls.

TRAIL INFORMATION: This trail is maintained only during the summer months. The trail is a moderate grade but stay on the trail, as hazards exist off the trail. View the falls from the top of the bank at the falls.

PASS NOT REQUIRED: A Northwest Forest Pass is NOT REQUIRED at trailhead.

OPPORTUNITIES: Day hiking and picture —taking. Peek-a-boo views of Mt. Jupiter and Jupiter Ridge. Good place for camera shots of the high, picturesque Murhut Falls. Practice LEAVE NO TRACE techniques during your trip.

CLOSURES: Trail is closed to motorized vehicles, stock, and mountain bikes.

TOPO MAPS: The Brothers USGS Quad. Note: This is a new trail and does not show on the quad.
