## Stack Demo Summary October 24, 2002 Tex Tin Site

A public ceremony was held on October 24, 2002 adjacent to the Tex Tin site to commemorate and witness the concrete smokestack demolition project milestone.

## **Event Agenda**

The event consisted of comments from city, state, federal agency and PRP representatives, plus the actual demolition of the smokestack.

The event was hosted by Mr. Myron Knudson, EPA Region 6 Superfund Director. Texas City Mayor Carlos Garza spoke first, generally thanking everyone who brought the cleanup to fruition.

Mr. Mike Cook, the EPA Superfund and Remediation Director, also thanked all the participants and emphasized the role of the PRP's.

Mr. David Davis, Deputy Director of the TCEQ also thanked everyone and praised the cooperative nature of the cleanup team.

Mr. Edgard Bertaut, Co-Chair of the Tex Tin Group Steering Committee presented a speech praising the cooperation from government and the exemplary safety record of the field personnel.

After the speeches, Mayor Garza concluded the ceremony with a countdown and symbolic detonation of the smokestack. The demolition itself was performed expertly, with the concrete structure dramatically rumbling down, timed exactly to coincide with the Mayor's symbolic detonation.
