SPF-SIG: Karen Wheeler gave a broad overview of the Strategic Prevention Framework Grant and presented a handout regarding the process for the application of the grant as well as the model to be used (merger with SB555) and infrastructure within the state, who the grant will fund, and that it will refine all previous processes.
