Breakfast Blueberry Waffles

- 1 1/2 cups sifted all-purpose flour
- 2-3 tablespoons vegetable oil
- 1/2 cup nonfat dry milk
- 3 eggs, separated
- 2 teaspoons baking powder
- 1 1/4 cups water or milk
- 1/2 teaspoon salt
- 1 cup fresh Blueberries

Heat a waffle iron according to directions. Sift all dry ingredients into a mixing bowl and make a whole in the center. Add egg yolk, water (or milk) and oil. Mix with the dry ingredients until smooth. Fold in 1 cup fresh blueberries. Beat egg whites until they stand in firm, moist peaks. Fold egg yolk mixture into beaten egg whites and bake in a hot waffle iron. Remove waffle from iron when it is brown. Serve hot at once as the main dish for breakfast with melted butter or margarine, Alabama syrup, Alabama honey, or top with Alabama strawberries. Makes 4 servings.
