Nevada Import Requirements for Canadian Cattle

A Certificate of Veterinary Inspection (CVI).

Each shipment of cattle, regardless of sex or age requires an entry permit. The permit is valid for the duration of the CVI.

Official individual identification as approved by USDA.

Individual listing of said official ID on the CVI.

Brucellosis vaccination for all females 4 months and older.

Negative Brucellosis test on all sexually intact animals 18 months and older within 30 days of entry.

Negative TB test for all sexually intact animals 6 months and older within 30 days of entry.

Negative Trichomonosis test (culture) for all bulls 8 months and older within 30 days before entry. No contact with females between test and entry.

- One negative Trichomonosis test is sufficient for those bulls where Trichomonosis <u>was not</u> diagnosed in the herd of origin in the previous 12 months.
- Three negative Trichomonosis tests are required for those bulls where Trichomonosis <u>was</u> diagnosed in the herd of origin in the previous 12 months.

All Cattle except for immediate slaughter require a 'CAN' brand on the right tailhead.

Registered Cattle may enter without a 'CAN' brand if they have a 'CAN' tattoo.

Slaughter cattle must be delivered directly to a slaughter establishment and may not be diverted without written permission from the State Veterinarian.
