INTRODUCTION

Singly and in partnership, the Kentucky Department of Fish and Wildlife Resources continues to provide outdoor recreational opportunities for persons with disabilities. In addition to qualified hunters and anglers receiving method exemptions, access is available at several Kentucky locations open to the public for fishing, hunting and wildlife viewing. Several wildlife management area field offices are also accessible. Conservation campers who stay at Camp Earl Wallace or Camp Robert E. Webb will find accessible bathhouses.

The following locations are accessible to most individuals with disabilities. Accessible parking is available in several areas.

FISHING

Anderson County

Beaver Lake: Gravel parking area; concrete sidewalk; floating pier

Ballard County

Ballard WMA.

Shelby Lake: Gravel parking area; floating pier (Pier closed during winter months and times of high water.)
Handicap Pond: Gravel parking area;

concrete pier

Daviess County

Carpenter Lake: Two parking areas; cross paved road to access floating pier

Franklin County

Game Farm Lake (upper): Blacktop parking area; blacktop path to floating pier

Grant County

Lloyd WMA Lake: Gravel parking area; blacktop path to concrete pier

Greenup County

Greenbo State Park Lake: Paved parking area; concrete sidewalk to floating pier

Johnson County

Paintsville WMA Lake: Paved parking area; concrete walkway

Lawrence County

Yatesville WMA Lake: Paved parking area; paved ramp to fixed jetty

McCracken County

West Kentucky WMA Lake: Gravel parking area; wooden pier

Mason County

Maysville Public Fishing Pier: Blacktop parking area; concrete pier

Pendleton County

Kincaid State Park Lake: Gravel parking area; floating pier
