

# Getting, Installing and Setting-up MacTV

Please print these instructions before starting.

## Getting the Program

1. Begin at the Laboratory HomePage (<http://int.lanl.gov>)
2. At the bottom of the left column on the HomePage, locate “ESD” under the category “Services”.  
<Click on “ESD”>.
3. A new window will appear  
Enter your Z-number and TokenCard passcode in the appropriate boxes  
<Click on the “Enter” button>.
4. A window titled, “Welcome to ESD” will appear
  - a. <Click on the “Enter” button>.
  - b. In the lower one-third of this window find the button for “Macintosh”  
<Click on the “Macintosh” button>.
  - c. Enter “MacTV” into the box titled “Product Name Contains”  
<Click on the “Find” button>
5. A window titled, “Software For Sale” will appear
  - a. Enter “1” in the box to the left of “MacTV”
  - b. Make sure that the Cost Code info is correct  
<even though the viewer is free>.
  - c. <Click on the “Order” button> near the bottom of the window.
6. A new window will appear titled, “Thank You for Using ESD”
  - a. <Click on the “Get Software” button>.
7. A new window will appear titled, “Getting MacTV”
  - a. Under the category “Web Download” <Click on “Download”  
(You will need to use your own judgment regarding the version of the software that you need to download.)
8. A new window titled, “MacTV 1.xxx” will appear and an additional new window will appear showing that a file is being mounted on your desktop computer.  
(The MacTV software will be transferred automatically to your computer and a folder will be created on your desktop titled, “MacTV 1.xx)

## Setting-up and Installing the Program

1. Open the “MacTV 1.xx folder on your desktop
2. Locate two MacTV files/icons titled,  
“MacTV OS 9”  
“MacTV OS X”  
<Double click on the icon that is compatible with our Mac’s operating system”>.

AT THIS POINT YOUR DIVISION COMPUTER SUPPORT PERSONNEL MAY HAVE BLOCKED YOU FROM COMPLETING THE INSTALLATION OF SOFTWARE ON YOUR COMPUTER. If this block window appears contact your computer support personnel.

3. A new window titled, "Select a Content Manger Host" wiill appear.
  - a. <Click on "Set Content Manager Now" button>.
  - b. A New window will appear titled, "Define Content Host" will appear. This window contains a list of server names that serve TV signals to your computer
  - c. Be sure there is a check in front of the option titled, "iptvhost"
  - d. <Click on the "Close" button>.
4. A new window titled, " MacTV Program Guide" will appear.
  - a. An option to check the clock time and date on your computer may appear  
(Click on the "OK" button if it appears
  - b. A list of program channel will appear – ( Sample MSNBC, FOXNews, CNBC, CNN, UCTV, LABNET 9 and LABNET 10, etc.)
5. A new window will appear titled, "Quicktime Connect Speed"
  - a. <Click on the "Internet/LAN" option>.
  4. <Click on the "Transfer Set" button>.
6. A new window will appear
  - a. <Click on the "Auto-select Best Connection Speed" option>.

#### **Watching a LABNET Television Channel**

1. The window titled, "MacTV 1.xx" will open be open choices of cable channel" in a column  
(Sample MSNBC, FOXNews, CNBC, CNN, UCTV, LABNET 9 and LABNET 10, etc.).
2. <Double click on the "CNN News"> line in the column
3. A new window will open that is a TV screen and a live television picture will appear that is the live feed from CNN News.
  - a. Adjust the volume
4. Open other channels in other windows using the available channel titles on the right.
