

O R D E R

USE OF MOTORIZED VEHICLES ON FOREST DEVELOPMENT ROADS
BLACK HILLS NATIONAL FOREST

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(b), this order establishes traffic rules to prevent damage to Forest Development Roads and to avoid conflict with other resource management objectives on the Black Hills National Forest. This order prohibits:

The use of any motorized vehicle on Forest Development Roads when traffic causes unacceptable damage to the road surface or is in conflict with other resource management objectives. (36 CFR 261.54(a))

On the ground signing will indicate when closures are in effect (36 CFR 261.51(b)). Roads can be temporarily closed and reopened at the discretion of the local District Ranger.

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(e), each of the following is exempted from this order:

- (1) Any military, fire, rescue, or law enforcement vehicle when used for emergency purposes; and,
- (2) Any vehicle whose use is expressly authorized by the Forest Supervisor under a permit, lease, license, contract, or for the performance of any official duty.

This order rescinds the order dated 2 April 1982.
