

ORDER  
OCCUPANCY AND USE RESTRICTIONS  
BOXELDER FORKS AREA  
BLACK HILLS NATIONAL FOREST

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(a) and (b), the following is prohibited within the BOXELDER FORKS AREA - A, located in Sections 20, 29, and 30, T.3N., R.5E., within the Black Hills National Forest and more specifically shown on the attached map. This Order prohibits:

- (1) POSSESSION OR USE OF ANY MOTORIZED VEHICLE ON NATIONAL FOREST SYSTEM LANDS. {36 CFR 261.54(b)}.


Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(a) and (b), the following is prohibited within the BOXELDER FORKS AREA - B, located in Sections 20, 21, 28, and 29, T.3N., R.5E., within the Black Hills National Forest and more specifically shown on the attached map. This Order prohibits:

- (1) CAMPING AT ALL AREAS OTHER THAN AT DEVELOPED SITES POSTED AS CAMPGROUNDS. {36 CFR 261.58(e)}.
- (2) USING OR POSSESSING A MOTOR VEHICLE OFF FOREST DEVELOPMENT ROADS. {36 CFR 261.56}.

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(e), each of the following is exempted from this order:

Any Federal, State or Local Officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty or person whose use is authorized by the Forest Supervisor under a permit, lease, license or contract.

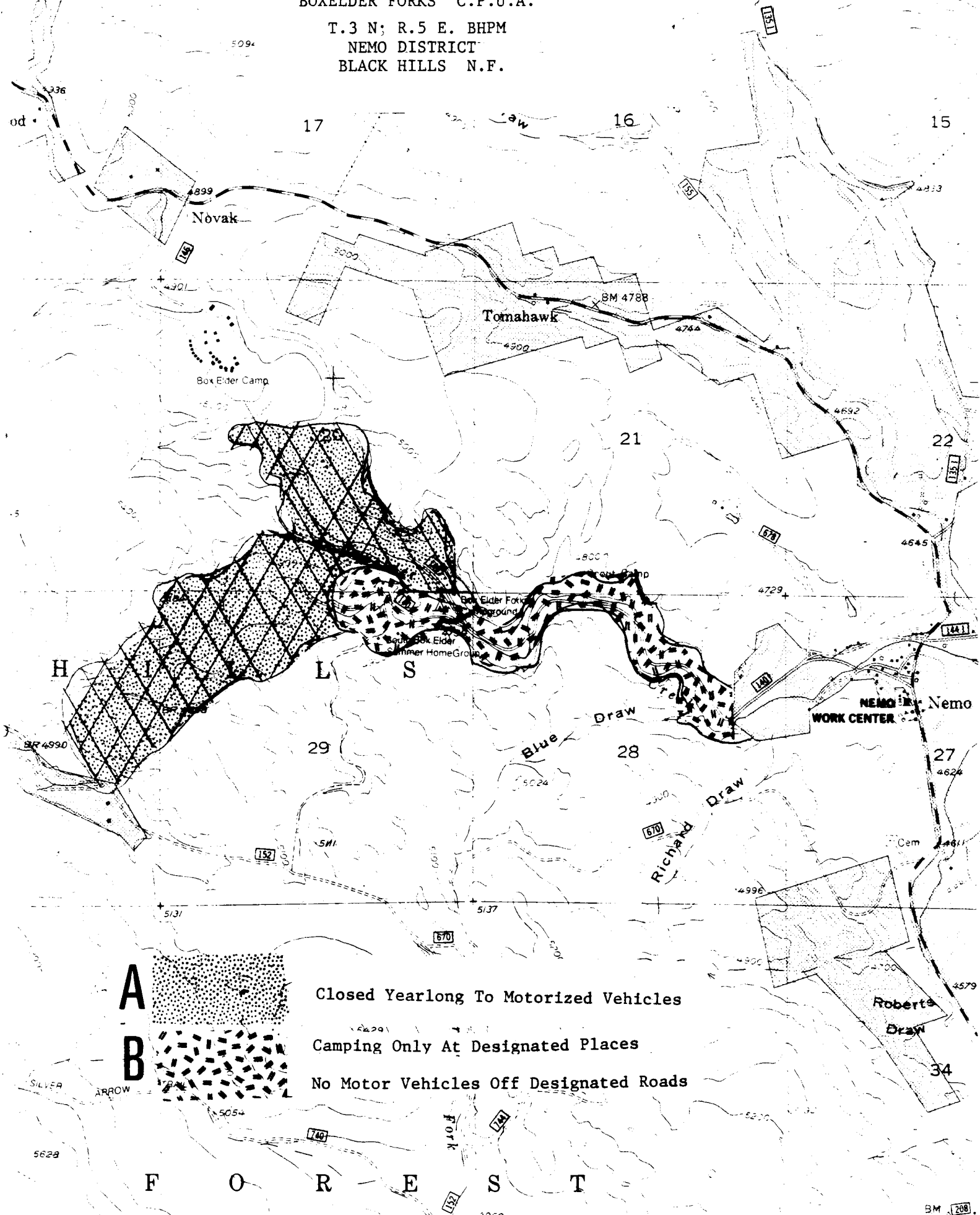
