ORDER
OCCUPANCY AND USE RESTRICTIONS
BLACK HILLS NATIONAL FOREST
RESERVATION CAMPGROUNDS

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(a), the listed prohibition applies to the following reservation campgrounds on the Black Hills National Forest: Cook Lake, Reuter, Bismarck Lake, Comanche Park, Dutchman, Horsethief Lake, Oreville, Whitetail, Pactola, and Sheridan Lake Southside, (reservations may be made for approximately 50 percent of the units within these campgrounds). In addition, the listed prohibition applies to the following group areas which are reservation-only campgrounds: Willow Creek Horse Camp, and Sheridan Lake North Cove Group Areas. This Order prohibits:

- (1) CAMPING OR OTHERWISE OCCUPYING UNITS WITHOUT A VALID RESERVATION VOUCHER OR UNIQUE RESERVATION NUMBER, UNLESS SPECIFICALLY AUTHORIZED BY THE CAMPGROUND ATTENDANT OR FOREST OFFICER FOR A SPECIFIED PERIOD OF TIME. [36 CFR 261.58(b)].

Violation of these prohibitions is punishable by a fine of not more than \$5,000.00 or imprisonment for not more than 6 months, or both.
