## ORDER OCCUPANCY AND USE RESTRICTIONS BOXELDER CIVILIAN CONSERVATION CORPS BLACK HILLS NATIONAL FOREST

Pursuant to 36 CFR 251.50(a) and (b), the following is prohibited within the Boxelder Civilian Conservation Corps located in Section 20, T.3N., R.5E. within the Black Hills National Forest and more specifically shown on the attached map. The only exemption to this Order is the Staff Housing. This Order prohibits:

(1) Furnishing, possessing, or consumming an alcoholic beverage as defined under South Dakota State Statute 35-9-1, 35-9-2, and 35-9-4. {36 CFR 261.58(bb)}.

This Order supersedes the Order entitled, "Occupancy and Use Restrictions, Boxelder Civilian Conservation Corps", dated July 11, 1990, approved by Darrel Kenops, Forest Supervisor.

Violation of these prohibitions are punishable by a fine of not more than \$5000.00, or imprisonment for not more than 6 months, or both.
