## ORDER

## OCCUPANCY AND USE RESTRICTIONS BLACK HILLS BURLINGTON NORTHERN HERITAGE TRAIL BLACK HILLS NATIONAL FOREST

Pursuant to 36 CFR Section 261.50(a) and (b) each of the following is prohibited on National Forest System Lands on and within the right-of-way of the Black Hills Burlington Northern Heritage Trail between Edgemont and Lead/Deadwood, South Dakota, as shown on the attached map. This Order prohibits:

- (1) OPERATING ANY MOTORIZED VEHICLE ON THE TRAIL AND WITHIN THE RIGHT-OF-WAY BETWEEN EDGEMONT AND ROCHFORD, SOUTH DAKOTA. {36 CFR 261.55(b)}
- OPERATING ANY MOTORIZED VEHICLE ON THE TRAIL AND WITHIN THE RIGHT-OF-WAY EXCEPT SNOWMOBILES BETWEEN ROCHFORD AND LEAD/DEADWOOD, SOUTH DAKOTA. SNOWMOBILES MAY BE USED ONLY ON THOSE PORTIONS IDENTIFIED ON THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA'S ANNUAL SNOWMOBILE OPERATING PLAN. (36 CFR 261.55(b))

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(e), the following is exempt from this order: Any Federal, State or Local Officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty or person whose use is authorized by the Forest Supervisor under a permit, lease, license or contract.
