ORDER

USE RESTRICTIONS FOR MOTORIZED VEHICLES IN THE VICTORIA AREA

BLACK HILLS NATIONAL FOREST

Pursuant to 36 261.50(a) and (b), this order establishes traffic rules to prevent resource damage to both areas and Forest Development Roads located in the NE 1/4 Section 6, T1S, R6E; portions of Sections 21, 26, 27, 28, 29, 34 and 35, T1N, R6E, BHM in Pennington County South Dakota, within the Black Hills National Forest boundaries in the Victoria area located on the Pactola Ranger District as shown on the attached map.

This Order prohibits:

The use of any motorized vehicle on areas and Forest Development Roads (FDR) 159.1A, 159.2A and 159.2B within the Victoria area shown on the attached map for a period of 2 to 4 years. The length of the closure will be determined by vegetative response on areas severely impacted. Annual inspection of the areas will be made to determine recovery of the area from resource damage. (36 CFR 261.54(a) and 36 CFR 261.56)

Roads and areas outside the closure can be seasonally closed and reopened at the discretion of the local District Ranger.

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(e), each of the following is exempted from this order:

- (1) Persons with a permit specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.
- (2) Owners or lessees of land in the area.
- (3) Any Federal, State or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or firefighting force in the performance of an official duty.
- (4) Any other person meeting exemption requirements specified in the order.


