

TRAVEL ORDER  
UPPER SPRING CREEK TRAVEL MANAGEMENT AREA  
BLACK HILLS NATIONAL FOREST  
HARNEY RANGER DISTRICT


Pursuant to 36 CFR 251.50(a) and (b), the following acts are prohibited in the area and roads in the portion of the Harney Ranger District, Black Hills National Forest known as the Upper Spring Creek area, southwest of Hill City, South Dakota. The area is shown on the attached map.

1. Using or possessing a motorized vehicle off Forest Development Roads from January 1 through June 30. (36 CFR 261.56)
2. Being on a road with a motorized vehicle in the travel management area when the roads are closed as indicated by a "Road Closed" sign. (36 CFR 261.54(a))

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(e), each of the following is exempt from this order:

1. Any Federal, State or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty; and
2. Persons with a permit specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.
