ORDER

OCCUPANCY AND USE RESTRICTIONS

COOK LAKE PUBLIC USE AREA

BLACK HILLS NATIONAL FOREST

Pursuant to $36\ \text{CFR}\ 261.50(a)$ and (b), the following are prohibited within the Cook Lake and Cliff Swallow Trail Recreation Area, located in Section 10 and $15,\ T.52N.,\ R.63W.,$ within the Black Hills National Forest, and more specifically as shown on the attached map.

Cook Lake Campground and Cliff Swallow Trail area means that area including and surrounding Cook Lake as shown on the attached map. This order prohibits:

- 1. OPERATING ANY MOTORIZED VEHICLE ON THE CLIFF SWALLOW TRAIL {261.55(b)}.
- 2. POSSESSING OR USING A SADDLE, PACK OR DRAFT ANIMAL ON THE CLIFF SWALLOW TRAIL {261.55(c)}.
- 3. BUILDING OR MAINTAINING A CAMPFIRE IN THE DAY UST AREA. GRILL FIRES USING CHARCOAL BRIQUETTES OR PRESSURIZED GAS STOVES MAY BE USED. {261.52 (a) \.
- 4. POSSESSING OR OPERATING A MOTORBOAT (EXCEPT ELECTRIC MOTORS), ON COOK LAKE. $\{36 \text{ CFR } 261.58(n)\}.$

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(e), the following are exempt from this order:

Any Federal. State or Local Officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty or person whose use is authorized by the Forest Supervisor under a permit, lease, license, or contract.

Violation of these prohibitions is punishable by a fine or not more than \$5000.00, or imprisonment for not for than 6 months, or both.
