## TRAVEL ORDER BIGHORN SHEEP TRAVEL MANAGEMENT AREA BLACK HILLS NATIONAL FOREST PACTOLA/HARNEY RANGER DISTRICT

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(a) and (b), the following acts are prohibited in the area, on roads and utility line Rights of Way described in the portion of the Pactola/Harney Ranger District, Black Hills National Forest known as the Bighorn Sheep Area located in Sections 1, 2, 10, 11, 12, 13 and 14, TlS, R6E, BHM in Pennington County, South Dakota. The area is shown on the attached map.

- (1) Possessing or using a vehicle off Forest Development Roads (FDR) 368, 369, 369.1A, 370, 514, 514.1A, 514.1B, 514.1C, 514.1D, 514.1E, 514.1F, 679.1A and utility line Rights of Way within the Bighorn Sheep Area. The length of the closure will be determined by a Cooperative Agreement between the South Dakota Game, Fish and Parks and the U. S. Forest Sevice. (36 CFR 261.56)
- (2) Being on a road with a motorized vehicle in the travel management area. (36 CFR 261.54 (a))

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(e), each of the following is exempted from this order:

- (1) Persons with a permit specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.
- (2) Owners or lessees of land in the area.
- (3) Any Federal, State or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or firefighting force in the performance of an official duty.
