## ORDER AREA and ROAD CLOSURE for MOTORIZED TRAVEL USDA – FOREST SERVICE BLACK HILLS NATIONAL FOREST

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50 (a) and (b), the following acts are prohibited from December 15 to May 15 in the area and on roads described in the portion of the Mystic Ranger District, Black Hills National Forest known as Blackhawk as shown on the attached map as Exhibit A\*, until rescinded.

- (1) Use of motorized vehicles off roads within the Blackhawk area. 36CFR 261.56
- (2) Use of motorized vehicles on roads within the Blackhawk area except those shown as open yearlong on the attached map\* 36CFR 261.54(a)

Pursuant to 36CFR, Section 261.50(e), the following are EXEMPT from the order.

- (1) Any vehicle whose use is expressly authorized by the Forest Supervisor under a permit, lease, license, contract, or for the performance of an official duty.
- (2) Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.
