COMPLETION OF DEFENSE NUCLEAR FACILITIES SAFETY BOARD (DNFSB) RECOMMENDATION 93-5 IMPLEMENTATION PLAN REVISION 1, MILESTONE 5.4.3.5d - "LETTER REPORTING QUALIFICATION OF ROTARY MODE CORE SAMPLING (RMCS) SYSTEM FOR USE IN FLAMMABLE GAS TANKS"

This letter reports qualification of RMCS for use in Flammable Gas Tanks. The due date for this milestone was September 1996. Completion progress has been reported in quarterly reports and other correspondence.
