The Copyright Office Catalog contains approximately 20 million records for works registered and documents recorded with the Copyright Office since 1978.

Included in one integrated database are registrations and preregistrations for books, music, films, sound recordings, maps, software, photographs, art, multimedia, periodicals, magazines, journals, newspapers, etc., as well as records for assignments, transfers, and other documents relating to copyright ownership.

Links to the Copyright Office homepage, Copyright FAQs, and information about services provided by the Office are available at the bottom of each screen.

Online help is always available by selecting links throughout the Catalog and by selecting "Help" from the top or bottom of each screen.

Overview of the Basic Search screen

By using the Basic Search screen you can:

- Specify the search term
- Search by either Title, Name, Keyword, Registration Number, Document Number, Command Keyword

Basic Search by Title

- A Title search finds works by title in the exact word order of the title
- Use this search when the exact title of the work is known
- Type the entire title, or the first few words of the title
- Omit initial articles, A, An, The, El, La, Das, etc.

Preregistration

Records for unpublished works in the process of being prepared for commercial distribution.

Serial

Registrations of periodicals, magazines, journals, and newspapers.

Monograph

Registrations of books, music, films, sound recordings, maps, software, photos, art, and multimedia. Also includes all renewals.

Document

Copyright ownership documents, such as name changes and transfers.

Basic Search by Name

- Search by all names, such as author, claimant, party 1, party 2 , etc.
- To search by a personal name, type the last name first name
- To search by a corporate name, type the name in word order

<i>Name type...</i>	<i>Search example...</i>
personal name	Crichton Michael
compound name	Marquez Gabriel Garcia
corporate name	Walt Disney Company

Basic Search by Keyword

- A Keyword search finds words, or phrases located *anywhere* in the record
- Use " " to surround exact phrases
- Type words or phrases in any order. All words will be searched, including "and", "the", etc.
- Use ? to search for a variation of a word, for example comput? finds compute, computer, computation
- Use + before words that must appear in every record retrieved
- Use ! before words that must not appear in any record retrieved
- Results will be ranked by relevance

Basic Search by Copyright Registration Number

- *All Copyright registration numbers must have a total of 12 characters*
- Type 2 letters followed by 10 numbers, or 3 letters followed by 9 numbers
- Omit spaces and hyphens when typing the number
- Add leading zeroes to the numeric portion of the registration number

Basic Search by Copyright Recorded Document Number

- *All document numbers must have a total of nine characters*
- The number after the "v" is always 4 digits; the number after the "p" or "d" is always 3 digits
 - Documents before V3400 use P + page number
 - Documents after V3400 use D + page number
 - *Note: V5000 and V8000 also use P + page number.*
- Omit spaces when typing the number

Setting Search Limits

- Select methods of limiting your searches below.
- Choose multiple **Item Types** by holding down the <Ctrl> key while selecting.
- Click on “**Set Search Limits.**” The message “**Search limits are in effect until you click on *Clear Search Limits***” will appear.
- Search limits will remain in effect until you specifically clear them or until you close your browser.

Limit by Date

- Limit your search by Date in 4 ways
 - Search only one year
 - Search a range of years
 - Search for all years before a date
 - Search for all years after a date

Limit by Item Type

- Use this limit to find a specific type of work
- Select multiple Item Types by holding down the <CTRL> key and clicking a term (Example: Limit search to Music and Sound Recordings)
- Limit your search to:
 - Recorded Documents
 - Text
 - Serials
 - Music
 - Maps
 - Sound Recordings
 - Computer Files
 - Motion Pictures
 - Visual Materials
 - Kits
 - Mask Works
 - Preregistration

Overview of "Other Search Options"

- Search for specific catalog records without knowing the complete title or full personal or corporate name
- Search by keyword using Boolean operators to combine or exclude words and phrases





Search Tips

1. **Optional** -- Set [Search Limits](#) **before** following the steps below.
2. **Search for:** -- Enter a word, several words, or a phrase in the box.
3. From the following drop-down menu, select **all of these**, **any of these** or **as a phrase** ("*all of these*" is the default, and is highly recommended).
4. **Search by:** -- Select an Index Name from the drop-down menu.
5. From the following radio buttons, select **AND**, **OR**, or **NOT** (boolean operators) to add more information to the search (see [Boolean Searching](#) help page for assistance).
6. Repeat steps 2, 3 and 4 to refine your search further by using the last set of fill-in blanks and menus.
7. Select the button to get results.

Boolean Searching

- Use Boolean operators to search for combinations of words or phrases. Enter Boolean operators (AND, OR, NOT) in either uppercase or lowercase
- Boolean operators **may** be used with the **Basic Search Command Keyword** or with **Other Search Options**.
- Boolean operators **may not** be used with the **Basic Search** types *Title, Name, Keyword, Registration Number or Document Number*

Concept	Search Examples	Retrieval Formula
AND	Rodgers AND Hammerstein "Civil war" AND Virginia rock AND roll	 Retrieves only records containing both terms.
OR	eighties OR 80s OR 1980s livin OR living email OR e-mail OR "electronic mail"	 Retrieves records containing either one or more terms.
NOT	Mexico NOT new jockey NOT disc "Civil war" NOT American	 Excludes records containing the second term.

How to Use Boolean Operators

- **AND** narrows the search by requiring all terms to be found in the record
- **OR** broadens the search by retrieving records if one or more of the terms is present
- **NOT** excludes terms from the search (use carefully, because NOT may eliminate relevant material inadvertently)

How to use "Other Search Options"

- Type a word or phrase in the "Search for:" box
- Select "all of these", "any of these", "as a phrase" from the drop-down list
 - "All of these": all of the words you type in the "Search for:" box must appear in the record
 - "Any of these": at least one of the words you type in the "Search for:" box will appear in the record
 - "As a phrase": the words you type in the "Search for:" box must appear in the record in the order typed
- Select an index name (Keyword anywhere is the default index and performs the broadest search)
- Click the "Begin Search" button to perform the search, OR
- Click AND, OR, NOT and fill in the next set of "Search for:" boxes

Sample Search

Basic Search | **Other Search Options**

Search for: inner peace | all of these | Search by: Title (no 6XX) (TKEY)

AND OR NOT

Search for: weiss | as a phrase | Search by: CO Claimant Stmt (K249)

25 records per page | Begin Search | Reset | Set Search Limits

Search for *"inner peace"* as *"all of these"* in a title field and *"weiss"* as a claimant.
