Subject: DESIGNATED U.S. INTERNATIONAL AIRPORTS

Date: 12/4/96

AC No: 150/5000-5C

Initiated by: AAS-3

Change:

1. PURPOSE. This advisory circular (AC) explains the different categories of U.S. airports designated to serve international air traffic and provides a listing of these airports.

2. CANCELLATION. AC 150/5000-5B, *Designated U.S. International Airports*, dated 7/28/88, is canceled.

3. BACKGROUND.

a. Under Section 1644a (b) (1), *19 United States Code*, the Secretary of the Treasury is authorized to "...designate ports of entry in the United States for civil aircraft arriving in the United States from a place outside the United States and property transported on that aircraft..." This responsibility is assigned to the U.S. Customs Service.

b. Article 68 of the *Convention on International Civil Aviation* provides for the designation by the signatory governments (referred to by the International Civil Aviation Organization (ICAO) as Contracting States) of "...the route to be followed within its territory by any international air service and the airports which any such service may use."

4. CATEGORIES OF INTERNATIONAL CUSTOMS AIRPORTS.

a. Designated International Airports of Entry (AOE). These airports have been designated as international airports for Customs purposes. They are open to all international aircraft for entry and clearance purposes without the necessity of obtaining prior permission to land. However, advance notice of arrival is required in order that inspectors may be made available. Designation as an international airport of entry follows application by the airport operator and finding by the U.S. Customs Service that the

airport will generate sufficient international traffic. An airport of entry must provide adequate space and facilities for Customs and Federal inspection purposes and satisfy certain other requirements established by the U.S. Customs Service.

b. Landing Rights Airports (LRA). Landing rights airports are those airports where incoming international flights must obtain **prior permission to land** and must furnish advance notice of arrival to U.S. Customs. This category of airports includes many of the so-called major U.S. "international airports" (e.g., John F. Kennedy International, Chicago-O'Hare International, Los Angeles International, etc.). Advance notice of arrival may be transmitted via flight plans to those airports where Advise Customs (ADCUS) service is available. Such notice is treated as application for permission to land. Customs officers may, at their discretion, grant blanket "landing rights" to individuals or companies at certain airports for a specific period of time, in which case only advance notice of arrival is required. This type of blanket permission is generally given for scheduled airline flights at busy landing rights airports.

c. User-fee Airports. Certain airports which do not meet Customs criteria for clearance services can petition for landing rights as "user-fee" airports. Inspection costs at these airports are reimbursable, and aircraft operators, in turn, may be required to pay the airport operator for costs associated with obtaining Federal services.

d. ICAO-Designated U.S. Airports Serving International Operations. ICAO airports are those designated under Article 68 of the *Convention on International Civil Aviation* as airports serving international operations (for traffic or refueling purposes). U.S. airports so designated are identified in *ICAO Regional Air*

Navigation Plans, Document 8755 (North Atlantic, North American, and Pacific Regions) and Document 8733 (Caribbean and South American Regions) and include those regularly served by scheduled and nonscheduled international commercial air transport, those designated as alternates, and those used regularly by international general aviation flights.

e. Practical Definition of International Airport. In practice, any airport that provides U.S. Customs/Immigration services for arriving aircraft is an **international airport**.

5. UNOFFICIALLY NAMED INTERNATIONAL AIRPORTS. In addition to the designated international airports discussed above, there are a number of airports in the United States that contain the word "International" within their names but have no official designation. Nothing prohibits this practice, though it is discouraged. However, without any official designation, these airports have no international status.

6. RELATED READING MATERIAL.

a. The U.S. Customs Service publishes a booklet, *Airports Federal Inspection Facilities - Guidelines*, which contains guidance material on the physical and facility requirements of airport terminals to accommodate the inspection of international traffic. A free copy of this booklet can be obtained by writing to: U.S. Customs Service, 1301 Constitution Avenue, NW., Washington, DC 20229, ATTN: Director, Passenger Enforcement and Facilitation.

b. The *Airport/Facility Directory (A/FD)* indicates up-to-date information in data element 15 on the type of international airport. It is for sale by the National Ocean Service, National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration (NOAA), N/ACC3, Distribution Division, Riverdale, MD 20737; telephone (800) 638-8972.

c. The *International Flight Information Manual (IFIM)* contains up-to-date information on airports of entry and landing rights airports. Information on the hours of availability and notification procedures for Federal inspection services are included. An annual subscription for the manual may be purchased from the Superintendent of Documents, U.S. Government Printing Office, Washington, D.C. 20402.

d. U.S. Airports designated by ICAO to serve international operations are listed in the following documents.

7. LISTING OF U.S. AIRPORTS SERVING INTERNATIONAL AIR TRAFFIC.

a. Appendix 1 is a list of U.S. airports designated as airports of entry and landing rights airports as of January 1994. Changes in Federal Inspection Service locations, hours, and limitations occur frequently; consequently, Appendix 1 should not be used for flight planning. For this purpose, the IFIM should be consulted.

b. Appendix 2 contains a listing of U.S. ICAO designated airports serving international operations which are included in (or in the process of being included in) the *ICAO Regional Air Navigation Plans*.
