

Pursuant to 21 C.F.R. Subpart F, section 101.93, Chattem, Incorporated ("Chattem", the distributor, which is located at 1715 West 38th Street, Chattanooga, TN 37409) wishes to notify the Food and Drug Administration that it has, within the past 30 days of this notification, commenced marketing a dietary supplement product which bears statements of nutritional support in its labeling.

The following statements are being made for a revised formula of Dexatrim ResultsTM, which does not contain ephedrine-alkaloids.

- Nutrition based weight control, Energy, Drug Free Dietary Supplement with Natural Metabolizers
- Help you control your appetite and cravings
- Increase your metabolism so you burn more fat and calories
- And give you added energy

These statements are accompanied by the required disclaimer, which is prominently displayed in a box in bold-faced type. I certify that the information contained in this notification is complete and accurate, and that Chattem maintains on file substantiation to attest that these statements are truthful and non-misleading.
