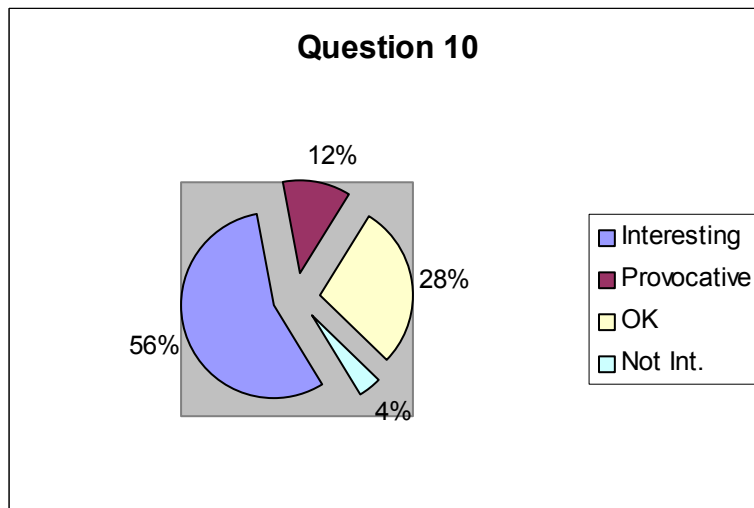

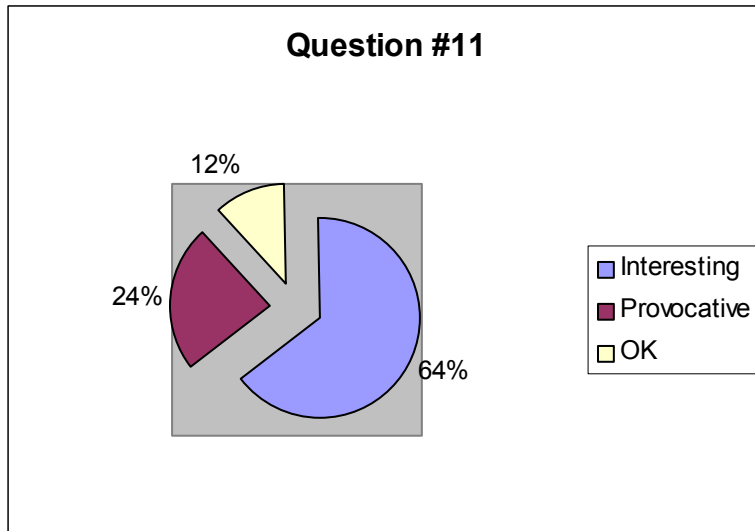

- *Although I got the impression that some folks more interested in talking than listening.*

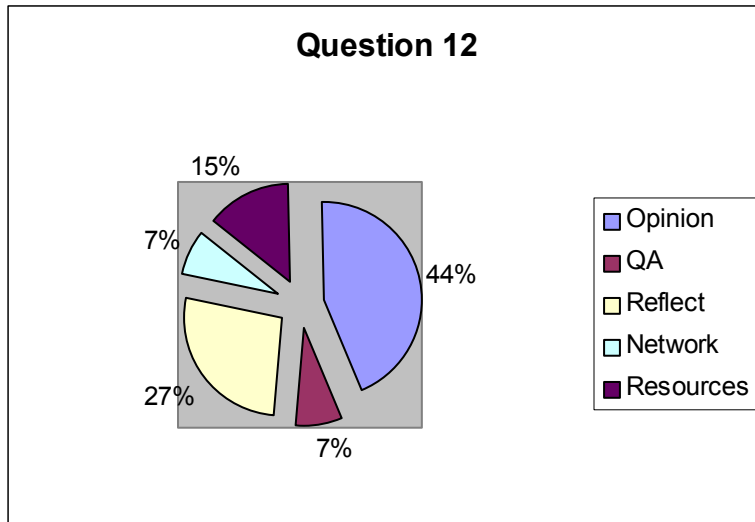

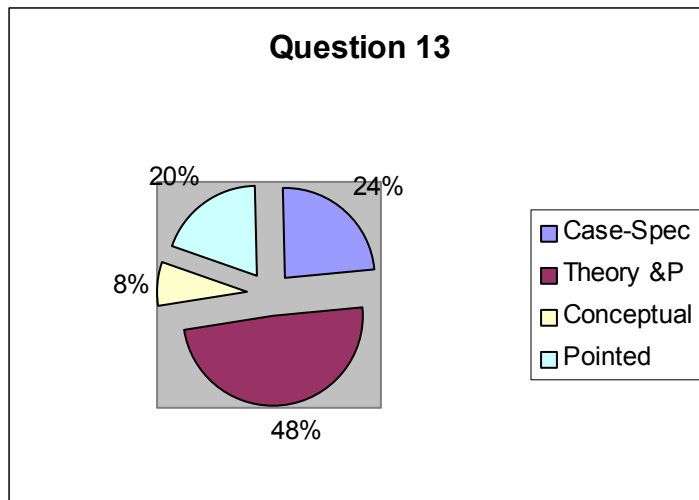

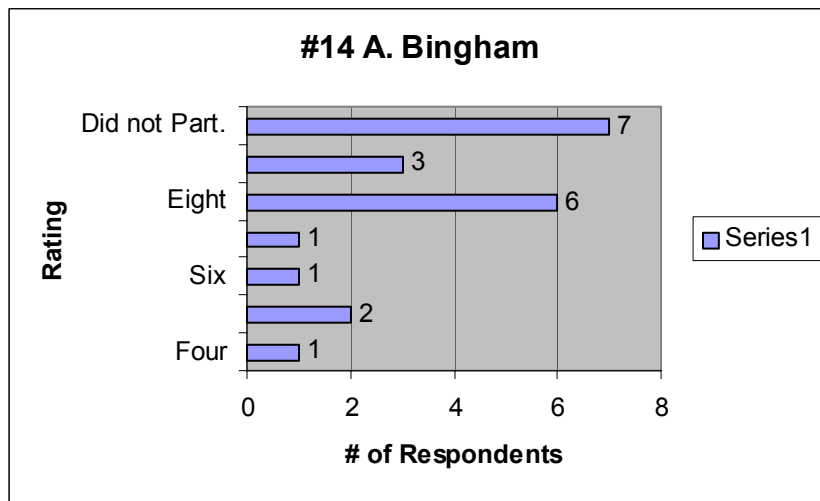
Question 13. Other.

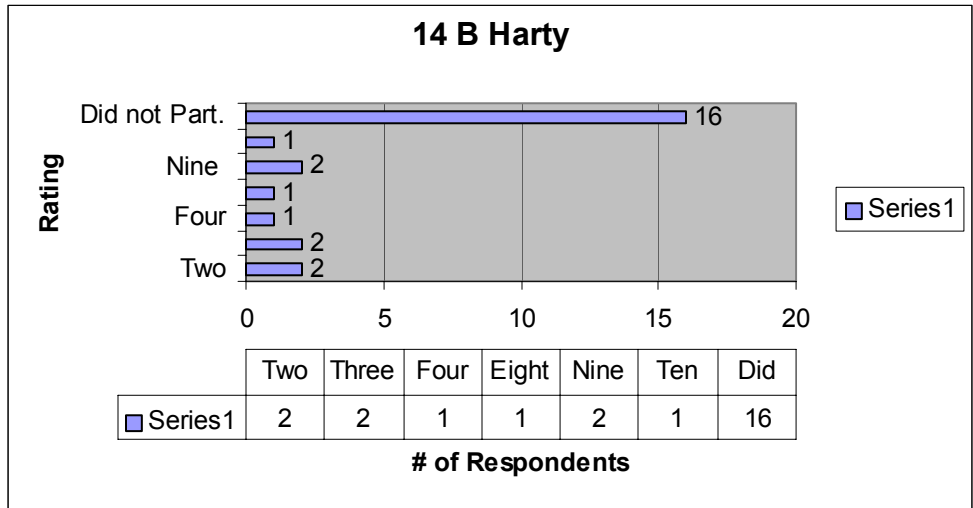

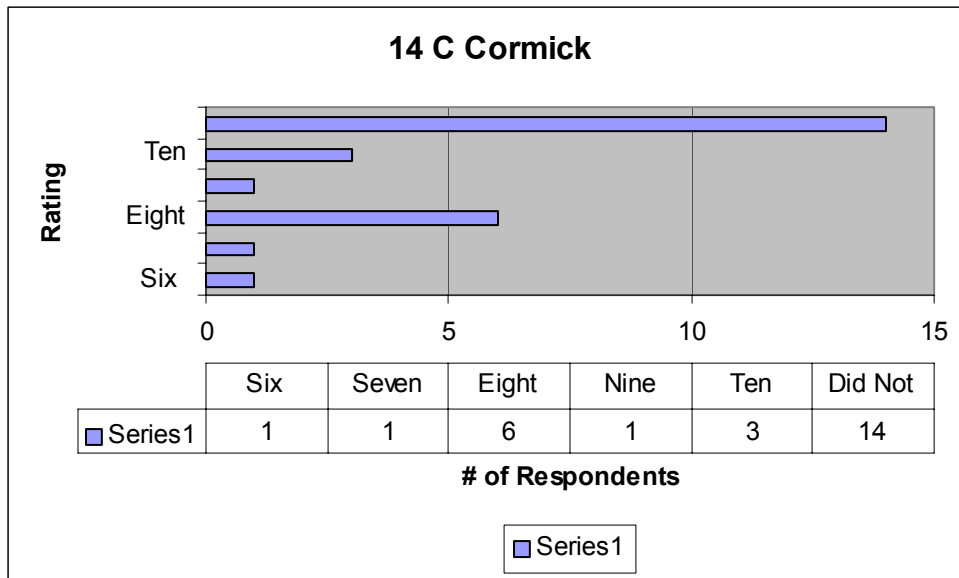
