Management Fund

General Statement

The NIH Management Fund (MF) was established on June 29, 1957, by Public Law 85-67. The MF was created to finance a variety of centralized research support services and administrative activities that are required for the efficient and effective operation of all NIH programs and facilities. The NIH appropriations and other government agencies pay the expenses for these activities. The services provided by the MF include a research hospital and outpatient clinic, receipt, review and referral of research and training grant applications, collaborative computer science research and general administrative support services. Funds credited to the NIH Management Fund shall remain available for one fiscal year after the fiscal year in which they are deposited.
