

## Summary Report of Occurrences Reviewed From October 27 – 31, 2008

**Summary:** 20 occurrences at 13 sites reviewed during this period.

### Significant Occurrences (1)

#### Conduct of Operations – 1 occurrence at 1 site

- **SC – Lawrence Berkeley National Laboratory (Significance Category R).** On October 23, following a review of Fiscal Year 2008 4th Quarter Performance Analysis of ORPS and Price Anderson Amendment Act (PAAA) Noncompliance Tracking System reportable incidents, LBNL management reported a recurring issue specific to the lack of or inadequacy of maintenance performance. LBNL has a documented maintenance program for some equipment, but not for others. In some instances, program documents and implementation are lacking or less than adequate for various types of equipment, including fire protection, emergency management, electrical distribution, and vehicle maintenance. The appropriate cognizant manager(s), subject matter experts, and the ORPS and PAAA coordinators have been made aware of the issues.
