1641	Read this Medication Guide carefully before you start to use ADVAIR HFA Inhalation
1642	Aerosol.
1643	Keep this Medication Guide because it has important summary information about ADVAIR
1644	HFA. This Medication Guide does not contain all the information about your medicine. If you
1645	have any questions or are not sure about something, you should ask your doctor or pharmacist.
1646	Read the new Medication Guide that comes with each refill of your prescription because there
1647	may be new information.
1648	
1649	What is the most important information I should know about ADVAIR HFA?
1650	ADVAIR HFA contains 2 medicines:
1651	• fluticasone propionate (the same medicine found in FLOVENT [®]), an inhaled
1652	corticosteroid medicine. Inhaled corticosteroids help to decrease inflammation in the
1653	lungs. Inflammation in the lungs can lead to asthma symptoms.
1654	• salmeterol (the same medicine found in SEREVENT [®]), a long-acting beta ₂ -agonist
1655	(LABA) medicine. LABA medicines are used in patients with asthma. LABA medicines
1656	help the muscles around the airways in your lungs stay relaxed to prevent symptoms,
1657	such as wheezing and shortness of breath. These symptoms can happen when the muscles
1658	around the airways tighten. This makes it hard to breathe. In severe cases, wheezing can
1659	stop your breathing and cause death if not treated right away.
1660	• In patients with asthma, LABA medicines, such as salmeterol (one of the medicines in
1661	ADVAIR HFA), may increase the chance of death from asthma problems. In a large
1662	asthma study, more patients who used salmeterol died from asthma problems compared with
1663	patients who did not use salmeterol. It is not known whether fluticasone propionate, the other
1664	medicine in ADVAIR HFA, changes your chance of death from asthma problems seen with
1665	salmeterol. Talk with your healthcare provider about this risk and the benefits of treating your
1666	asthma with ADVAIR HFA.
1667	ADVAIR HFA does not relieve sudden symptoms. Always have a short-acting

1668 beta₂-agonist medicine with you to treat sudden symptoms. If you do not have an


1669 1670	inhaled, short-acting bronchodilator, contact your healthcare provider to have one prescribed for you.
1671 1672	• Do not stop using ADVAIR HFA unless told to do so by your healthcare provider because your symptoms might get worse.
1673 1674 1675	• ADVAIR HFA should be used only if your healthcare provider decides that another asthma-controller medicine alone does not control your asthma or that you need 2 asthma-controller medicines.
1676 1677	• Call your healthcare provider if breathing problems worsen over time while using ADVAIR HFA. You may need different treatment.
1678 1679 1680 1681 1682	 Get emergency medical care if: breathing problems worsen quickly, and you use your short-acting beta₂-agonist medicine, but it does not relieve your breathing problems.
1683	What is ADVAIR HFA?
1684	ADVAIR HFA combines an inhaled corticosteroid medicine, fluticasone propionate (the same
1685	medicine found in FLOVENT) and a LABA medicine, salmeterol (the same medicine found in
1686	SEREVENT).
1687	ADVAIR HFA is used long term, twice a day to control symptoms of asthma, and prevent
1688	symptoms such as wheezing in adults and adolescents 12 years of age and older.
1689	ADVAIR HFA contains salmeterol (the same medicine found in SEREVENT). Because
1690	LABA medicines, such as salmeterol, may increase the chance of death from asthma
1691	problems, ADVAIR HFA is not for adults and children with asthma who:
1692	• are well controlled with another asthma-controller medicine, such as a low to medium dose
1693	of an inhaled corticosteroid medicine
1694	 only need short-acting beta₂-agonist medicines once in awhile
1695	
1696	Who should not use ADVAIR HFA?
1697	Do not use ADVAIR HFA:
1698	to treat sudden severe symptoms of asthma
1699	• if you are allergic to any of the ingredients in ADVAIR HFA. See the end of this Medication
1700 1701	Guide for a list of ingredients in ADVAIR HFA.
1702	What should I tell my healthcare provider before using ADVAIR HFA?
1703	Tell your healthcare provider about all of your health conditions, including if you:
1704	have heart problems
1705	have high blood pressure
1706	have seizures
1707	have thyroid problems

1708	have diabetes
1709	have liver problems
1710	have osteoporosis
1711	have an immune system problem
1712	• are pregnant or planning to become pregnant. It is not known if ADVAIR HFA may harm
1713	your unborn baby.
1714	• are breastfeeding. It is not known if ADVAIR HFA passes into your milk and if it can harm
1715	your baby.
1716	are allergic to ADVAIR HFA or any other medicines
1717	are exposed to chickenpox or measles
1718	Tell your healthcare provider about all the medicines you take including prescription and
1719	non-prescription medicines, vitamins, and herbal supplements. ADVAIR HFA and certain other
1720	medicines may interact with each other. This may cause serious side effects. Especially, tell your
1721	healthcare provider if you take ritonavir. The anti-HIV medicines NORVIR [®] (ritonavir capsules)
1722	Soft Gelatin, NORVIR (ritonavir oral solution), and KALETRA® (lopinavir/ritonavir) Tablets
1723	contain ritonavir.
1724	Know the medicines you take. Keep a list and show it to your healthcare provider and
1725	pharmacist each time you get a new medicine.
1726	
1727	How do I use ADVAIR HFA?
1728	See the step-by-step instructions for using ADVAIR HFA at the end of this Medication
1729	Guide. Do not use ADVAIR HFA unless your healthcare provider has taught you and you
1730	understand everything. Ask your healthcare provider or pharmacist if you have any questions.
1731	• Use ADVAIR HFA exactly as prescribed. Do not use ADVAIR HFA more often than
1732	prescribed. ADVAIR HFA comes in 3 strengths. Your healthcare provider has prescribed the
1733	one that is best for your condition.
1734	• The usual dose of ADVAIR HFA is 2 inhalations twice a day (morning and evening). The 2
1735	doses should be about 12 hours apart. Rinse your mouth with water after using ADVAIR
1736	HFA.

1739	• While you are using ADVAIR HFA twice a day, do not use other medicines that contain

1741	(fluticasone propionate and salmeterol inhalation powder), SEREVENT [®] DISKUS [®]
1742	(salmeterol xinafoate inhalation powder), FORADIL® AEROLIZER® (formoterol
1743	fumarate inhalation powder), ${f SYMBICORT}^{m @}$ (budesonide and formoterol fumarate
1744	dihydrate) Inhalation Aerosol, PERFOROMIST ^{TM} (formoterol fumarate) Inhalation
1745	Solution and RROVANATM (arformatoral tartrata) Inhalation Solution

(arformoterol tartrate) Inhalation Solution. 1745 Solution, and BROVANA¹

1746 1747	• Do not change or stop any of your medicines used to control or treat your breathing problems. Your healthcare provider will adjust your medicines as needed.
1748 1749 1750	• Make sure you always have a short-acting beta ₂ -agonist medicine with you. Use your short-acting beta ₂ -agonist medicine if you have breathing problems between doses of ADVAIR HFA.
1751 1752 1753 1754 1755 1756 1757 1758 1759 1760 1761 1762 1763	 Call your healthcare provider or get medical care right away if: your breathing problems worsen with ADVAIR HFA you need to use your short-acting beta₂-agonist medicine more often than usual your short-acting beta₂-agonist medicine does not work as well for you at relieving symptoms you need to use 4 or more inhalations of your short-acting beta₂-agonist medicine for 2 or more days in a row you use 1 whole canister of your short-acting beta₂-agonist medicine in 8 weeks' time your peak flow meter results decrease. Your healthcare provider will tell you the numbers that are right for you. you have asthma and your symptoms do not improve after using ADVAIR HFA regularly for 1 week
1764	What are the possible side effects with ADVAIR HFA?
1765	ADVAIR HFA contains salmeterol (the same medicine found in SEREVENT). In
1766	patients with asthma, LABA medicines, such as salmeterol, may increase the chance of
1767	death from asthma problems. See "What is the most important information I should know
1768	about ADVAIR HFA?"
1769	Other possible side effects with ADVAIR HFA include:
1770	• serious allergic reactions including rash; hives; swelling of the face, mouth, and tongue;
1771	and breathing problems. Call your healthcare provider or get emergency medical care if you
1772	get any symptoms of a serious allergic reaction.
1773	increased blood pressure
1774	 a fast and irregular heartbeat
1775	chest pain
1776	headache
1777	• tremor
1778	• nervousness
1779	 immune system effects and a higher chance for infections
1780	• lower bone mineral density. This may be a problem for people who already have a higher
1781	chance for low bone density (osteoporosis).
1782	• eye problems including glaucoma and cataracts. You should have regular eye exams while
1783	using ADVAIR HFA.
1784	• slowed growth in children. A child's growth should be checked often.

1785	throat irritation
1786	• pneumonia. ADVAIR HFA contains the same medicine found in ADVAIR DISKUS.
1787	ADVAIR DISKUS is used to treat people with asthma and people with chronic obstructive
1788	pulmonary disease (COPD). People with COPD have a higher chance of getting pneumonia.
1789	ADVAIR DISKUS may increase the chance of getting pneumonia. ADVAIR HFA has not
1790	been studied in people with COPD.
1791	Common side effects of ADVAIR HFA include upper respiratory tract infection and
1792	headache.
1793	Tell your healthcare provider about any side effect that bothers you or that does not go away.
1794	These are not all the side effects with ADVAIR HFA. Ask your healthcare provider or
1795	pharmacist for more information.
1796	Call your doctor for medical advice about side effects. You may report side effects to FDA at
1797	1-800-FDA-1088.
1798	
1799	How should I store ADVAIR HFA?
1800	Store at room temperature with the mouthpiece down.
1801	Contents Under Pressure: Do not puncture. Do not use or store near heat or open flame.
1802	Exposure to temperatures above 120°F may cause bursting.
1803	Do not throw into fire or an incinerator.
1804	Keep ADVAIR HFA and all medicines out of the reach of children.
1805	
1806	General information about ADVAIR HFA
1807	Medicines are sometimes prescribed for purposes other than those listed in a Medication
1808	Guide. Do not use ADVAIR HFA for a condition for which it was not prescribed. Do not give
1809	your ADVAIR HFA to other people, even if they have the same condition that you have. It may
1810	harm them.
1811	This Medication Guide summarizes the most important information about ADVAIR HFA. If
1812	you would like more information, talk with your healthcare provider or pharmacist. You can ask
1813	your healthcare provider or pharmacist for information about ADVAIR HFA that was written for
1814	healthcare professionals. You can also contact the company that makes ADVAIR HFA (toll free)

1817	What are the ingredients in ADVAIR HFA?
1818	Active ingredients: fluticasone propionate, salmeterol xinafoate
1819	Inactive ingredient: propellant HFA-134a
1820	
1821	How to use your ADVAIR HFA
1822	The parts of your ADVAIR HFA:



1825 There are 2 main parts to your ADVAIR HFA inhaler— 1826 the metal canister that holds the medicine and the purple 1827 plastic actuator that sprays the medicine from the canister 1828 (see Figure 1).

1829 The inhaler also has a cap that covers the mouthpiece of 1830 the actuator. The strap on the cap will stay attached to the 1831 actuator.

1832 Do not use the actuator with a canister of medicine

1833 from any other inhaler. Do not use an ADVAIR HFA

The canister has a counter to show how many sprays of medicine you have left. The number

1836 shows through a window in the back of the actuator.

1837 The counter starts at 124. The number will count down by 1 each time you spray the inhaler.

1838 The counter will stop counting at 000.

1839 Never try to change the numbers or take the counter off the metal canister. The counter 1840 cannot be reset, and it is permanently attached to the canister.

1841 **Before using your ADVAIR HFA:**


- 1842 Take the inhaler out of the foil pouch. Safely throw away the foil pouch and the drying packet that comes inside the pouch. The counter should read 124. 1843
- 1844 The inhaler should be at room temperature before you use it.
- 1845 Check each time to make sure the canister fits firmly in the plastic actuator. Also look into the
- 1846 mouthpiece to make sure there are no foreign objects there, especially if the strap is no longer
- 1847 attached to the actuator or if the cap is not being used to cover the mouthpiece.

1848 **Priming your ADVAIR HFA:**

- 1849 Before you use ADVAIR HFA for the first time, you must prime the inhaler so that you will
- 1850 get the right amount of medicine when you use it. To prime the inhaler, take the cap off the
- mouthpiece and shake the inhaler well for 5 seconds. Then spray it 1 time into the air away from 1851
- 1852 your face. Shake and spray the inhaler like this 3 more times to finish priming it. Avoid
- 1853 spraying in eyes. The counter should now read 120.
- 1854 You must prime your inhaler again if you have not used it in more than 4 weeks or if you have 1855 dropped it. Take the cap off the mouthpiece, shake the inhaler well for 5 seconds, and spray it
- 1856 into the air away from your face. Shake and spray the inhaler like this 1 more time to finish
- 1857 priming it.

Instructions for taking a dose from your ADVAIR HFA: 1858

- 1859 Read through the 7 steps below before using ADVAIR HFA. If you have any questions, ask
- 1860 vour doctor or pharmacist.




- 1866 1. Take the cap off the mouthpiece of the actuator. Shake1867 the inhaler well for 5 seconds before each spray.
 - 3 2. Hold the inhaler with the mouthpiece down (see Figure
 2). Breathe out through your mouth and push as much
 air from your lungs as you can. Put the mouthpiece in
 your mouth and close your lips around it.
 - 2 3. Push the top of the canister all the way down while
 you breathe in deeply and slowly through your
 mouth (see Figure 3). Right after the spray comes out,
 take your finger off the canister. After you have breathed
 in all the way, take the inhaler out of your mouth and
 close your mouth.
- 1878 4. Hold your breath as long as you can, up to 10 seconds,1879 then breathe normally.
- 1880 5. Wait about 30 seconds and shake the inhaler again for 51881 seconds. Repeat steps 2 through 4.
- 1882 6. After you finish taking this medicine, rinse your mouth1883 with water. Spit out the water. Do not swallow it.
- 1884 7. Put the cap back on the mouthpiece after every time you1885 use the inhaler, and make sure it snaps firmly into place.

1886 When to replace your ADVAIR HFA:

- When the counter reads 020, you should refill your prescription or ask your doctor if you need another prescription for ADVAIR HFA.
- **Throw the inhaler away** when the counter reads 000. You should not keep using the inhaler when the counter reads 000 because you will not receive the right amount of medicine.
- **Do not use the inhaler** after the expiration date, which is on the packaging it comes in.

1892 How to clean your ADVAIR HFA:



- 1895 Clean the inhaler at least once a week after your evening1896 dose. It is important to keep the canister and plastic actuator1897 clean so the medicine will not build-up and block the spray.
 - 8 1. Take the cap off the mouthpiece. The strap on the cap
 9 will stay attached to the actuator. Do not take the
 0 canister out of the plastic actuator.
 - Use a dry cotton swab to clean the small circular
 opening where the medicine sprays out of the canister.
 Carefully twist the swab in a circular motion to take off
 any medicine (see Figure 4).

- 1905 3. Wipe the inside of the 1908 water. Let the actuator air-dry overnight.
