1. Respondents served their Production Request on July 29, 2003. Under Rules

17.23(d) and 17.30(c), were the Government to respond by seeking a protective order, the deadline for its motion would be August 13, 2003.

The Government objects to many of the particular requests in the Production
Request. But the Government and Respondents are trying to resolve these objections
