Subject: Revision of Thrift Savings Plan Comprehensive Tables of Annuity Rates

Date: April 13, 2001

The Federal Retirement Thrift Investment Board (Board) has revised the *Thrift Savings Plan Comprehensive Tables of Annuity Rates.* A copy of the revision, dated February 2001, is attached to this bulletin. **This revision reflects the latest annuity rates and supersedes all prior versions of the comprehensive tables.** Consequently, agencies should discard all prior versions of the comprehensive tables when they receive this bulletin.

The comprehensive tables supplement the tables contained in the booklet *Thrift Savings Plan Annuities*, revised February 2001 and attached to TSP Bulletin 01-13, dated March 30, 2001. Participants who are not covered by the age ranges of the tables contained in the Annuity Booklet may refer to these tables for the factors they need to estimate the monthly payments of various Thrift Savings Plan (TSP) annuities. Participants may also use the calculator on the TSP Web site (www.tsp.gov) to estimate TSP annuities. Although the comprehensive tables are not available from the Web site, the annuity calculator is programmed to consider these factors in relevant estimates.

Agency responsibilities. Agency representatives should keep the attached copy of the comprehensive tables in their offices as a reference for those participants who are not covered by the tables in the Annuity Booklet. The booklet of tables is not for general distribution, and the Board is not sending additional copies to agencies through the TSP distribution process.
