In the past, the Thrift Savings Plan (TSP) has issued posters and brochures in conjunction with the semi-annual TSP open seasons. These materials were used by the agencies and uniformed services to promote the open seasons and encourage informed participation in the TSP.

Although the TSP open seasons were eliminated last year, the TSP will continue to issue Spring and Fall posters. This Spring, the poster's theme is "There's a Better Way" to save for retirement. Please display the posters in highly visible areas, such as employee lounges, hallways, cafeterias, etc. Even though participants may now join the TSP or change their elections at any time, it is important to remind them to periodically think about their TSP investments and the impact of their saving decisions on their future retirement security. The posters are an easy way to remind them.
