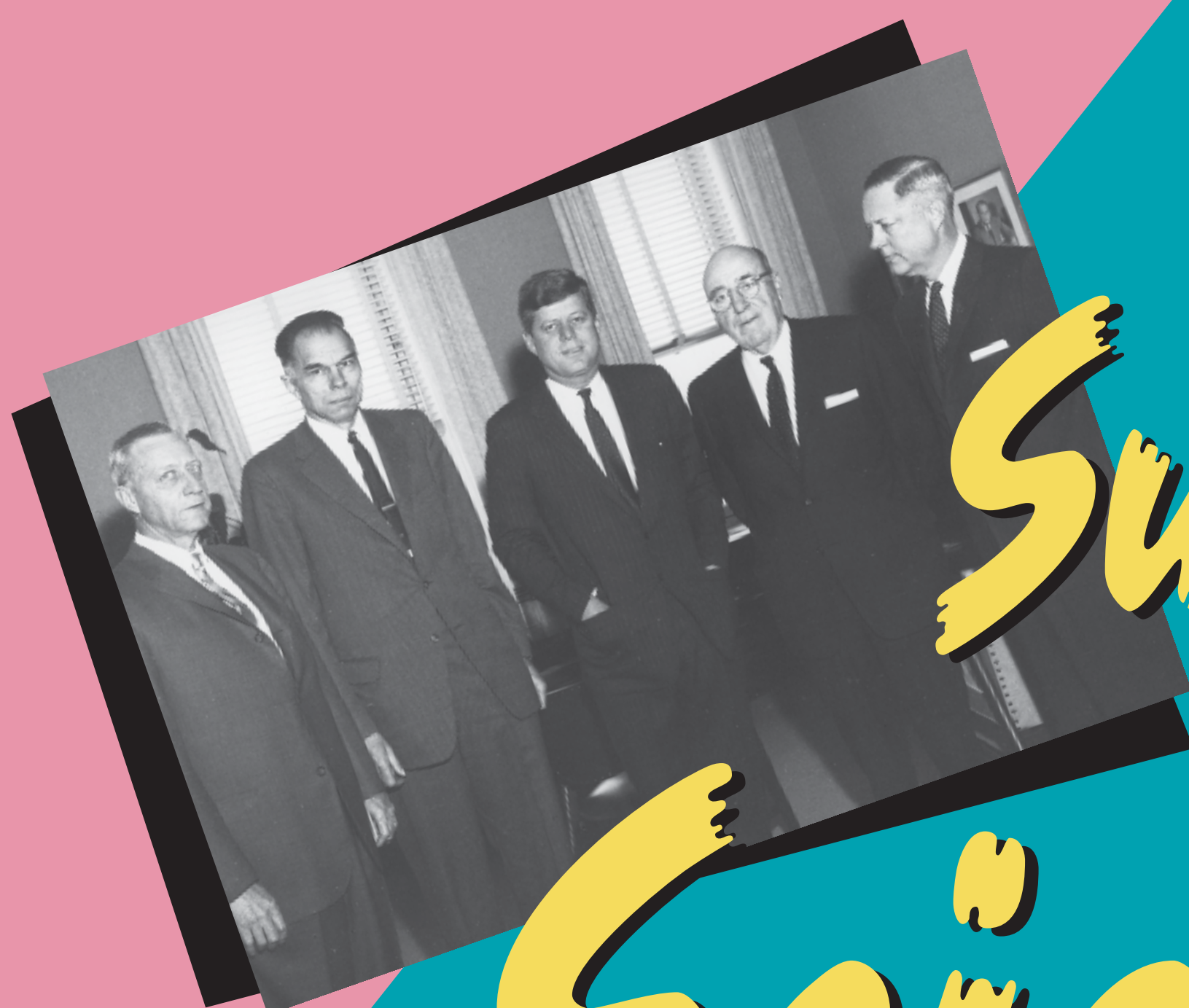
1962 Supplied science information to Atoms-for-Peace libraries worldwide

1962 Published first "Understanding the Atom" booklets

1963 Weinberg Report issued by White House stated that transfer of information is an inseparable part of research

1963 Supported exhibits worldwide on uses of the atom for energy and its promise in medicine

1964 Distributed half-million booklets at New York World's Fair

1967 Computer processing of information began

1968 Managed 316 foreign science information exchange agreements in 44 countries

1969 Played a leading role in creation of International Nuclear Information System

1969 Created instructional series for elementary school science, "The World of the Atom"
