Significant Outcomes from DOE Research and Development

The Department of Energy (DOE) Research and Development (R&D) Accomplishments Web site is a central forum for information about the outcomes of past DOE R&D and is available **free** to the public.

The Web site contains:

▶ Searchable Database

- selected documents about noted accomplishments
- documents and individual pages searchable by word or phrase
- documents and individual pages can be downloaded
- bibliographic data

▶ Featured Topic pages

- renowned scientists, with insights into the scientist's body of research and links to related documents and Web pages
- significant DOE research disciplines, with summary information and links to related documents and Web pages

▶ Nobel Laureates

- Laureates associated with DOE and predecessor agencies
- alphabetical or chronological navigation

▶ Snapshots

- quick pictures, introductions, overviews or synopses of DOE accomplishments
- links to items, articles, and documents with information about, or the identity of, at least one accomplishment

▶ Nuggets

- complementary to accomplishments
- wide-ranging, interesting scientific insights and/or educational resources and materials

The outcomes featured have had significant economic impact, have improved people's lives, or have been widely recognized as a remarkable advance in science.

The content spans from the historical Manhattan Project era (beginning in the 1940's) through more recent accomplishments, including the latest Nobel Laureates associated with DOE.
