· How have you gotten through rough times before?

What would you do differently if it happened again?

. How did you help others? How would you help next time?

Note*

As the teacher, you might think of more leading questions to ask the children. Be sure that your questions are

"OPEN > ENDED," which means that they can not be answered by a "Yes" or "No" only. Open-ended auestions facilitate verbal expression.

Description → Most of these ouestions would be helpful at any time after a disaster/event, from one day following, to one or more years later.
