Charitable Investments Focus:

Grants are focused on projects that encourage the development of youth in our community so that the next generation workforce is skilled, educated, and maintains values important to our communities.

Areas of Investment:

Education – Science, Technology, Engineering and Math. This is our primary area.

Arts & Culture - Develop family/youth appreciation for the arts and diverse cultures.

Civic & Public Interest - Promote workforce development and public safety.

Health & Human Services – Primarily through our United Way contributions.

Volunteerism - Support employee participation projects focused on youth

Types of Fund Available:

- **\$1,000 or less** - are considered monthly on a year round basis
- **More than \$1,000** - are considered once a year.
Proposals must be submitted by August 1 for project occurring in the next year. (Grants are administered in January.)

Funding Limitations:

The Lockheed Martin/Sandia National Laboratories Corporate Contributions program **cannot** fund the following type of projects:

- Projects or organizations that discriminate by race, creed, gender, sexual orientation, age, religion, or national origin
- Home-based child care/educational services, private schools
- Individuals (including business start-ups, scholarships, sponsorships, or travel)
- Religious organizations for religious projects
- Professional associations, labor organizations, fraternal organizations, or social clubs
- Athletic groups
- Advertising
- Travel
- Research
