This letter is to register my concern and disapproval of the Memorandum of Understanding as published on January 24, 1977, in its present form. The memorandum, as well as the corresponding Section 503A of the Drug Enforcement Act, severely limits the rights of physicians and patients to obtain health care products from the providers of their own choice and to the rights of consumers, pharmacists to serve the public as medical needs. I do not believe restrictions to the ability of a compounder medication prescriber to one should not depend upon where a line is drawn. The provision of the act, however, I believe 1104 should be revised.
