Dear FDA Persons,

I have just learned that the FDA MOU and Compounding Section 503A of the Modernization Act would limit the rights of patients to get compounded medications across state lines. My husband needs a compounded prescription and we understand the need to support compounding pharmacies and other patients who require compounded drugs. It would not be fair to penalize patients unable to afford to travel to get their medications. I also would not want to see compounding pharmacies suffer and possibly go out of business, unable to serve the patients that formerly had been helped across state lines.

I may not be in the majority, but I have been found to become ill from a synthetic hormone, whereas, a natural form gives me life. Yes, I am passionate about the need for compounding and alternatives to traditional medicines. I only wish I had more time to contact media and educate more people prior to your August 1 deadline.

Please, please do not restrict access to compounded medications!!!


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
