
Dear Dr. Henney:

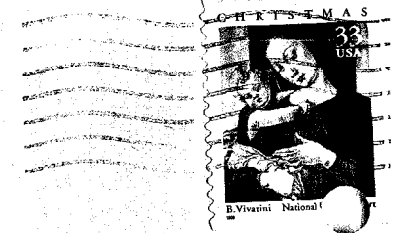
