Q20: Do think there are any threats to sea turtles near your village?




Figure 1.17 Existence of threats to sea turtles near respondent's village. Only 15% of respondents believed that there were threats to sea turtles near their village, despite the fact that threats to sea turtles are pervasive throughout the island.

Figure 1.37 Respondent able to name three effects of sand mining. Only 12% of respondents named three effects of sand mining. As evidenced by figure 1.39, many of those responses were incorrect, because less than 5% of respondents provided three correct answers. Thus knowledge of the negative effects of sand mining is limited and will be addressed by the campaign.


