Abstract: The Office of Federal Housing Enterprise Oversight will, upon receipt of requested guidance from the Department of Justice (DOJ), propose a regulation to effectuate section 119 of the Rehabilitation Comprehensive Services, and Developmental Disabilities Amendment of 1978, which amended a section of the Rehabilitation Act of 1973 to prohibit discrimination on the basis of disability in programs or activities conducted by executive agencies or the United States Postal Service.

3387. CORPORATE GOVERNANCE— PROHIBITION ON INDEMNIFICATION PAYMENTS

Abstract: OFHEO intends to solicit comments on a proposed amendment to the existing corporate governance regulation to enhance the minimum corporate governance standards applicable to the Enterprises by limiting indemnification payments by the Enterprises. The proposed rule would clarify that the Enterprises are subject to the same type of limits on indemnification of employees and directors as other federally regulated financial institutions. These limits help to prevent abuses in indemnity payments and help maintain safe and sound operations at the Enterprises. The proposed rule amendment is classified as Other Significant for regulatory planning and review and has not been classified as a major rule for purposes of the Small Business Regulatory Enforcement Fairness Act.
