What's New for DRVS 7.1.1

1. e-Submit function

When states have tried to e-submit their validation results using DRVS 7.1, they have received the following critical error:

2. Negotiated Values Data Entry for Table H.1

The first two data entry cells in the Negotiated Values Data Entry screen for Table H.1 are incorrectly labeled as "Entered Employment Rate" and "Employment Retention Rate." This is a labeling issue only.
