

To-Do List:

<p>Vehicle: Get estimates from car transport or driver service companies, if necessary.</p>	
<p>Computer:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Back up all files and store the external disk drive/CDs/etc. in a well-protected place. • Check owner's manual for special packing instructions. 	
<p>Appliances: Ask the moving company if they handle appliances.</p>	
<p>Valuables:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Make sure your moving company can handle items like a piano, pool table, fine art, or antiques. • Research special movers if you are doing a self-move but can't handle valuables or large items. • Make sure your valuables are fully insured before you move. Make sure your insurance policy covers loss or damage due to a move. 	

Things to Leave Behind:

- Aerosol cans
- Ammunition
- Firearms
- Matches
- Pesticides
- Fireworks
- Paint and varnishes
- Propane, motor fuels, and oils
- Nail polish remover
- Bleach

Be sure to get a complete list of what your moving company will not move. Common items moving companies won't move include:

- The hazardous items listed above, but individual companies may have a more comprehensive list, so be sure to ask your moving company for a more comprehensive list
- House plants
- Animals/pets
- Perishable foods
