#### Momentum for a 10-yr Anniversary of IYOR


- Original IYOR in 1997
- Global conversations about need for continued improvements in conservation and global to local awareness
- Major entities pass resolutions to move forward in November 2005:



- International Coral Reef Initiative (ICRI)
- U.S. Coral Reef Task Force (CRTF):
   Resolution 14-8 tasks Education/Outreach and International Working Groups with "developing options and recommendations (in collaboration with the International Coral Reef Initiative) on a possible 2007 Year of the Reef"

### Scoping Process: Nov 2005 - March 2006

- Created scoping paper with pros and cons for range of options (day vs. year, which year, etc)
- In-depth discussions with:
  - Key CRTF constituents
  - International partners
  - Others: e.g. National Coral Reef Institute (planning leads for ICRS)
- Gathered "lessons learned" from IYOR 1997 and other international years



## Recommended Option: IYOR 2008

- Scoping result: Strong domestic and international support for an IYOR, with 2008 as lead option.
- IYOR 2008 would:
  - Consist of a year-long campaign of events and initiatives hosted by governments and nongovernmental organizations around the world.
  - Be modeled after IYOR 1997 and other successful international years:
    - International and regional coordination
    - Centralized website with customizable information, tools and actions for international dissemination
    - International calendar of events
    - "Ownership" for IYOR should be global all welcome to participate, from communities upward



# U.S. Coral Reef Task Force

### Recommended Option: IYOR 2008

- IYOR 2008 would:
  - Center around a series of "high-visibility" events already planned for 2008:
    - U.S. to host International Coral Reef Symposium (ICRS)
    - Release of the World status report on coral reefs
    - Release of U.S. status report on coral reefs
    - 10<sup>th</sup> anniversary of CRTF
    - U.S. will serve as Co-Chair of the ICRI Secretariat
    - Others?
  - Magnify impact and facilitate linkages across these otherwise unrelated/uncoordinated events



## Next Steps?

- Endorsement by ICRI members at October 2006 meeting
- U.S. participation in international, national and regional planning and execution with ICRI, other partners
- Active U.S. leadership will require some combination of:
  - Financial support
  - Staff time
  - Content for events, announcements and products
