COURSE OBJECTIVES

- Describe the significance and role of fire and fire management in ecosystem management.
- Describe the complexity of integrating fire and vegetation management with social, political, legal, economic and environmental factors.
- Provide participants with tools, concepts, reference resources, techniques and methodologies to address fire and ecosystem management issues including collaboration with the public and other agencies.

COURSE DESCRIPTION

Through lectures, case studies, and interaction between participants and faculty, the course:

- Explores the role of fire and fire management in ecosystem management.
- Examines social, political, legal, economic, and environment factors critical to fire and fuels treatment for ecosystem management.
- Present real-world examples of fire management applications in ecosystem management throughout a range of ecosystems and scales.

Case studies from North America are presented to expose participants to a variety of ongoing programs attempting to integrate the historical, ecological and socioeconomic aspect of fire management into ecosystem management.

Nationally recognized subject matter experts and practitioners serve as instructors in this course.

The course does not provide a “cookbook” for ecosystem management, rather this course provides concepts, and ecological - social considerations to assist the student with developing specific fire management programs. Local fire effects information and monitoring details are provided in other courses.
