Los Alamos National Laboratory Superconductivity Licensing Policy

The University of California, operator of Los Alamos National Laboratory, is making its high temperature superconductivity intellectual property (patents and patent applications) available for non-exclusive licensing for a period of nine (9) months after the intellectual property has been posted on the Los Alamos Licensable Technologies web site. If available after the nine (9) month posting period, the University may negotiate exclusive licenses with entities requesting such a license. After the nine (9) month posting period, non-exclusive license agreements for a given technology may no longer be available. License Agreements may be offered in fields-of-use when deemed appropriate by the University. This Policy only applies to superconductivity technologies at Los Alamos National Laboratory posted at the following web site:
