I/We agree to the following: Establishment (Fill In) hereby enter into a Compliance Agreement with the United States Dept. of Agriculture (USDA) and the [REDACTED] Department of Agriculture [REDACTED] under the provisions of the Emerald Ash Borer quarantine and agrees to ship regulated articles interstate only as provided for on this Compliance Agreement. <u>Logs, lumber, firewood, and bark are subject to additional regulations and requirements if moved outside of the area regulated for Gypsy Moth. Do not make commitments to move firewood outside of the area regulated for Gypsy Moth without contacting the USDA at [REDACTED].</u>			
This establishment will distribute hardwood firewood interstate from Distribution Center # [REDACTED] located in the quarantined area under the following conditions: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Firewood stored and distributed shall be either: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> a. Certified by USDA for treatment of EAB under an appropriate USDA compliance agreement or; b. Originate from an area not quarantined for EAB 2. Firewood bundles will be individually labeled <ol style="list-style-type: none"> a. Treated certified bundles will be labeled showing USDA approved status in a format approved by USDA-APHIS-PPQ b. Bundles originating from non-quarantined states will be labeled with origin to the state level at a minimum. 3. Firewood will not be stored outside at the Distribution Center while awaiting delivery to the retail stores. 4. Firewood will be transported in enclosed containers and/or vehicles. 			
The USDA and/or [REDACTED] retain the right to conduct inspections of regulated articles and examine shipment records at any time. Shipment records must be maintained for at least 24 months by this establishment and broker/supplier. All document requests will be filled within 96 hours of the initial request.			
If Establishment (Fill In) fails to comply with the provisions of this Compliance Agreement and/or the Emerald Ash Borer Quarantine regulations, this Compliance Agreement will be canceled. In addition, violations of federal regulations, including any alteration, forgery or unauthorized use of Federal forms, are subject to criminal penalties with monetary fines in accordance with 18 USC, imprisonment for a period not to exceed one year, or both, or civil penalties of up to \$500,000 (7UCS s7734 (b)). The USDA reserves the right to revise or cancel the Compliance Agreement at any time.			
This Compliance Agreement replaces and supersedes any other interstate Compliance Agreements issued to Establishment (Fill In) by the USDA for the handling of regulated articles described in box 3 above originating from a quarantined area. Compliance agreements are non-transferable. The establishment must notify the local USDA,APHIS,PPQ office in the event that: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The designated signatory individual in block 6 changes, • The applicant/company physically relocates, • The company name or ownership changes, or • Any other event which may affect the handling of the regulated article occurs.
