Federal Recall of Lawson's Product from Lowe's Retail Stores



The emerald ash borer (EAB) is a small, green, wood-boring beetle that is responsible for the death of millions ash trees in North America. Since its discovery in Southeastern Michigan in 2002, EAB has been detected in Canada and 6 other states; Ohio, Indiana, Illinois, Maryland, Pennsylvania and West Virginia.

Federal and state quarantines restrict the movement of regulated articles including ash nursery stock, green ash lumber, branches, stumps and <u>all</u> hardwood firewood.



Because EAB larvae live under the bark of ash trees, items made from unfinished ash, such as the Lawson's planters, pose a risk for the spread of EAB. Therefore in an effort to safeguard the forests and urban landscapes across the country, the U.S. Department of Agriculture has initiated this product recall.
