- The Federal Reserve Bank of Cleveland is the payment processor for ACH payments made via Pay.gov, and will appear as the ACH ODFI. FRB Cleveland processes under the ABA number 042736141. Please be sure that you have authorized debits originating from that ABA number.

The current CIP System is being replaced on October 1, 2007 with a fast, secure online system using your USDA eAuthentication ID.



Note: The current CIP system will not function as of October 1, 2007.

You must convert to this safe, secure method of paying your loan by **OCTOBER 1, 2007.**



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Loan Payment Requirements

If you currently use the CIP system, you need:

- USDA eAuthentication account
- Borrower Reference Number
- Your financial institution account and routing numbers

If you are not enrolled in CIP, you need:

- USDA eAuthentication account

- To fax the form to the Cash Management Branch at (314) 457-4370

To make your payment:

- Go to https://rdupcip.sc.egov.usda.gov
- Verify the financial information for your Location/Borrower ID
- Click on Schedule a Payment
- Enter your payment information





How to Establish an eAuthentication Account

- 1. Go to http://www.eauth.egov. usda.gov.
- 2. Create an account.
- 3. Choose Level ss2 access.
- 4. Complete the Create an Account Page information.
- 5. Submit.
- You will receive a confirmation by e-mail that requires activation of the account within seven calendar days.
- 7. Employees must be identityproofed at a USDA office by a Local Registration Authority. To find the nearest office, go to http://offices.usda.gov.
