child framed by rules. "moral code". Universal law.
crisis of generations - loss of reference groups.
analogy of victims

1. Thoreau - asking a German historian... Detonations & interventions ^{support to keep desori} ^{omniscient}
European history - right of resistance 16th C. reforms. Rejection...
message of redemption. Temporal: to avoid cowardly resistance;
must be passive. Statues - magistrates, political institutions. OK against
tyranny. Then resistance is necessary.

Europe did not follow this history. Rights of revolution asserted; Calvinism.
19th. Intervention vs revolution for Order. 20th. Resistance for Hitler
Nazis needed unmaking. Permission of order; Deter of Peace; Emergent as
dignity. Here danger of ban revolution. Conservatism: Hitler could not fulfill
peace treaties, could not be limited. Only total annihilation... Christian
tradition - forget sovereignty of human rights.
