

Fire Restrictions In Effect

At 12:01 a.m. on 07/04/07

These restrictions apply to all federal, state, and private lands throughout the state of Utah. This order does not affect incorporated towns and cities, or in the high Uinta Wilderness Area. Fire restrictions remain in effect until rescinded.

No fires outside developed recreational sites

You may **only** use portable stoves or lanterns fueled by petroleum or liquid propane gas (LPG) in undeveloped areas.

No Smoking

Except within an enclosed vehicle, camp trailer, or building, a developed recreation site, or while stopped in a area at least three feet in diameter that is barren or cleared to mineral soil.

No Fireworks

Discharging, or using any kind of fireworks, tracer ammunition, or other pyrotechnic device, in any location on all federal, state, and unincorporated private lands.



Developed Recreational Sites include:

An area which has been permanently improved or developed for recreation. A developed recreation site may be a campground or picnic area signed and identified on a map as a site developed for that purpose.
