Report Highlights:

Post forecasts increased palm oil production in 2001/2002 due to good rains in 2001, the entry into production of replanted trees and the recovery in world market price. Poor rainfall distribution in 2000 and repeated disruption of palm fruit delivery to processing firms contributed to the sharp drop in palm oil production in 2000/2001. Despite the fall in total oil exports, palm oil exports increased in 2001due to increased refined oil exports to neighboring countries. Total oil imports rose in 2001 due to increased crude palm oil imports to supplement local production.

Executive Summary

Post forecasts increased palm oil production in 2001/2002 due to good rains in 2001, the entry into production of replanted trees and improving world market price. Production fell in 2000/2001 due to poor rainfall distribution in 2000 coupled with the repeated disruption in palm fruit delivery to processing firms as a result of farmers' strike action against reduced producer price. In January 2001, low world market price of palm oil caused processing firms to reduce producer price of palm fruit from 23 F CFA/kg in 2000 to 19.07 F CFA/kg in early 2001. However, it was later raised to 20 F CFA/kg after farmers' agitation. Currently, producers are expecting the producer price to be increased to 30 F CFA/kg.

Total oil exports fell in 2001 due to reduced supply and relatively high domestic sale. Total oil exports in 2001 were 100,073 MT against 112,958 MT in 2000. Palm oil remains the most important export, accounting for about 75 percent of total oil exports in 2001. There was a slight increase in palm oil exports due to increased exports of refined palm oil to neighboring countries. Palm oil exports in 2001 were 74,505 MT compared to 72,190 MT in 2000. Refined palm oil export is expanding and in 2001, exports were 63,244 MT compared to 58,979 MT in 2000.

Total oil meal exports fell in 2001 due to the fall in supply coupled with low export demand. Exports in 2001 were 38,400 MT compared to 56,042 MT in 2000. Soybean imports in 2001 were only 500 MT, all from Brazil.

Total oil imports increased in 2001 due to increased imports of crude palm oil for domestic processing. Total oil imports in 2001 were 39,972 MT against 18,963 MT in 2000. In 2001, Cote d'Ivoire imported 33,205 MT of crude palm oil for domestic processing from Indonesia compared to 10,718 MT in 2000. Other vegetable oil imports were down due to relatively high prices. Refined palm oil imports in 2001 were 931 MT against 2,232 MT in 2000. Other imports of significance in 2001 were rapeseed oil, 1,245 MT against 1,827 MT in 2000; refined sunflower oil, 651 MT against 745 MT in 2000; olive oil, 1,330 MT against 733 MT in 2000.
